Plants must be healthy and thrive within the water requirements of the Metropolitan Water District. As it grows, no part of the plant may meet any part of the building. Protect the building from overspray when watering. Maximum size of hanging pot is 14" for safety and structural concerns. The hanging height of the pot must not interfere with landscaper's ability to work with Association plantings in common area. Replacement plants/pots must continue to match these criteria. 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#### <u>Architectural Control Committee (ACC) Specifications</u>

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#### **GENERAL**

This describes the requirements for SECURING ATTACHMENTS TO HOA PROPERTY.

#### **Approved Attachments:**

In general, attaching items to the following solid pieces of wood (at least 2" thick) using small screws or hooks that do not penetrate more than 1" should be approved:

- Barge rafters
- Rafter tails side or bottom-mount only
- Beams
- Porch posts
- Window frames
- Other large, solid wood members

#### **Unapproved Attachments:**

Attaching items at the following locations will not be approved for the stated reasons:

- Stucco, wood shingles, and roof shingles; such attachments can easily penetrate the
  underlying waterproof barrier which may cause water damage to the building's
  structure and/or interior. Exception: Garage-door controls may be attached to garage
  stucco provided the mounting holes are pre-drilled and filled with caulking before the
  mounting screws are installed.
- Wood starter boards under the roof located between the rafters; such attachments can easily pierce these thin boards, damage the roof shingles thereby allowing water to penetrate the underlying wood causing rot.
- Wood fence and wood gate top rails; attachments to these horizontal surfaces may allow standing water to enter the underlying wood causing rot.
- Vinyl fences, block fences, and their gates; repairs to these fence materials are difficult, costly, and unsightly.

#### PROCEDURE

- 1. A Unit floorplan (available at the Management office) must be included with your <u>Architectural Control Committee Application</u>, with locations of proposed changes being well marked in a contrasting color.
- 2. Installation must be done by a licensed contractor or insured handyman, who shall complete and sign the attached <u>Contractor Acceptance Agreement</u>. A copy is to be given to the ACC.

#### 3. Installation Requirements

- a. Mounting
- b. Painting
  - Plates and other materials (such as wood) used to fill gaps and fit the door to the building shall be painted a matching color to minimize their visibility.

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- ii. Surfaces shall be appropriately primed before painting. All painting shall be in accordance with Maintenance Specifications for Exterior Painting (available in the Management office).
- 4. A Notice of Completion is to be submitted to the Management office no later than ten days after completion for inspection and project file closure.

#### STANDARD CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS

- 1. All work is to be performed by a licensed and insured contractor per California law.
- 2. A copy of the pertinent ACC Standards, the ACC approval letter and the City of Huntington Beach permits must be kept available on the job site for the duration of the project.
- 3. All trash and material generated at the project site must be transported out of Huntington Landmark property by the contractor. Trash and material from the project cannot be placed in Association trash containers the owner is responsible for all costs to remove trash and material is found in Association trash containers.
- 4. The term "contractor" includes their employees, agents, subcontractors, suppliers, and any other person under their cognizance.
- 5. Work hours are designated Monday through Saturday, 7:30 am to 6:00 pm with the exception of emergencies.
- 6. No unnecessary noise, radios, or boom boxes be considerate of other residents.
- 7. Safety cones, yellow tape and any other type of precautionary items are to be in place by contractor at and around the project site when necessary.
- 8. Construction site must be left clean each day.
- 9. Construction items such as sand, cement, and dirt must not be placed on streets, walkways, or grass without protective underlying ground cover in place.
- 10. Parking restrictions, fire lanes, and speed restrictions must always be observed and respected.
- 11. Contractors are to park on the street not in Resident-only parking spaces adjacent to the garages.
- 12. Contact security at the Atlanta gate if you are unsure where to park.
- 13. No signs advertising the contractor may be posted at any time.
- 14. All contractor vehicles must be clearly identified with signage indicating to whom they belong. A dashboard permit must be obtained at the Atlanta gate security.
- 15. Owner must provide a copy of these requirements to their contractor.

# ADDITIONAL INSURED – OWNERS, LESSEES OR CONTRACTORS – AUTOMATIC STATUS WHEN REQUIRED IN CONSTRUCTION AGREEMENT WITH YOU

This endorsement modifies insurance provided under the following:

COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY COVERAGE PART

- A. Section II Who Is An Insured is amended to include as an additional insured any person or organization for whom you are performing operations when you and such person or organization have agreed in writing in a contract or agreement that such person or organization be added as an additional insured on your policy. Such person or organization is an additional insured only with respect to liability for "bodily injury", "property damage" or "personal and advertising injury" caused, in whole or in part, by:
  - 1. Your acts or omissions; or
  - The acts or omissions of those acting on your behalf;

in the performance of your ongoing operations for the additional insured.

However, the insurance afforded to such additional insured:

- Only applies to the extent permitted by law;
- **2.** Will not be broader than that which you are required by the contract or agreement to provide for such additional insured.

A person's or organization's status as an additional insured under this endorsement ends when your operations for that additional insured are completed.

**B.** With respect to the insurance afforded to these additional insureds, the following additional exclusions apply:

This insurance does not apply to:

- "Bodily injury", "property damage" or "personal and advertising injury" arising out of the rendering of, or the failure to render, any professional architectural, engineering or surveying services, including:
  - a. The preparing, approving, or failing to prepare or approve, maps, shop drawings, opinions, reports, surveys, field orders, change orders or drawings and specifications; or
  - **b.** Supervisory, inspection, architectural or engineering activities.

This exclusion applies even if the claims against any insured allege negligence or other wrongdoing in the supervision, hiring, employment, training or monitoring of others by that insured, if the "occurrence" which caused the "bodily injury" or "property damage", or the offense which caused the "personal and advertising injury", involved the rendering of or the failure to render any professional architectural, engineering or surveying services.

- "Bodily injury" or "property damage" occurring after:
  - a. All work, including materials, parts or equipment furnished in connection with such work, on the project (other than service, maintenance or repairs) to be performed by or on behalf of the additional insured(s) at the location of the covered operations has been completed; or
  - b. That portion of "your work" out of which the injury or damage arises has been put to its intended use by any person or organization other than another contractor or subcontractor engaged in performing operations for a principal as a part of the same project.
- C. With respect to the insurance afforded to these additional insureds, the following is added to Section III Limits Of Insurance:

The most we will pay on behalf of the additional insured is the amount of insurance:

- Required by the contract or agreement you have entered into with the additional insured; or
- **2.** Available under the applicable Limits of Insurance shown in the Declarations;

whichever is less.

This endorsement shall not increase the applicable Limits of Insurance shown in the Declarations.
